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Preparing for Surgery

What should I do to prepare for my surgery?

- 1. Arrange for a family member or friend to accompany you to the hospital the day of your surgery.
- 2. Plan ahead for transportation home or to the hotel the day of your planned discharge.
- 3. Remember to adjust your work/social schedule accordingly during your anticipated recovery time.
- 4. While taking narcotic pain medication, you will not be permitted to drive. You may need to arrange for transportation to your initial follow-up visit.
- 5. Unless told otherwise, you will need to have a follow-up visit 7-14 days after surger with Dr. Yanke.

What should I bring with me the day of surgery?

- 1. Photo ID
- 2. Insurance Card
- 3. Friend or family member who will be available the entire time and take you home after surgery
- 4. Wear comfortable, loose fitting clothing
 - o Shoulder surgery: zip-up or button down shirt
 - o Knee surgery: loose fitting pants or shorts
